## Classes Offered

Class	Description
<b>Bible</b>	Students will develop a knowledge of God’s Word, a focused heart on sharing the Gospel with the world, and a Biblical worldview.
<b>Music</b>	Students will continually answer the question: What do I say about the music I hear? Concepts taught are drawn from the six essential elements of music: Melody, Harmony, Rhythm, Form, Timbre, and Expression.
<b>Spanish</b>	Students will begin their introduction to Spanish by focusing on the four key areas of foreign language study: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.
<b>Art</b>	Students will explore the creative process, develop their artistic skills and experiment with a variety of art materials.
<b>Public Speaking</b>	Students will improve communication skills, increase self-esteem/confidence, plan and organize their thoughts, express their ideas in front of the class and develop leadership skills. Weekly “Performance Tips” are given and practiced during each class. This class will also incorporate Geography by studying states, countries, and continents.
<b>Science Lab</b>	Students will participate in experiments, engage in scientific reasoning, manipulate equipment, record data, analyze results, and discuss their findings.
<b>PE</b>	Students will participate in weekly sport activities and develop the knowledge, attitudes, motor skills, behavioral skills, and confidence needed to adopt and maintain physically active lifestyles.
<b>Sensory Activities</b> <b>*K2-K4 only</b>	<i>Sensory play</i> includes any activity that stimulates a child’s senses: touch, smell, taste, movement, balance, sight and hearing. Sensory activities facilitate exploration and naturally encourage children to use scientific processes while they <i>play</i> , create, investigate and explore. Activities will be based off monthly themes and incorporate letters, sounds, and numbers.

**\*The Homeschool Mom’s Support Group:** This “class” is for parents/guardians only! Participants will spend 30 minutes relaxing and getting to know each other during “Mom’s Moment.” Parents will then engage in discussions about homeschooling by asking/answering questions. We also encourage parents to share or demonstrate lessons/activities completed at home that have helped their child learn various academic concepts.
